Pursuant to the Articles 6 and 16 of the Law No. 03/L-60 on the National Qualifications dated November 7, 2008 and the Administrative Instruction No.1/2011 - Criteria and procedures for the validation and approval of the national qualifications and accreditation of institutions which provide qualifications in Kosovo, Articles 4, 7, 10 and 16, the Steering Council of the National Qualification Authority, on the date 15.01.2013 issues this:

DECISION

1. For non-formal programs, the timeframe of the validation for Information and Communication Technology qualification will depend on the agreement these institutions have with developers of these qualifications.
2. The timeframe of accreditation of institutions which provide, evaluate and issue these qualifications will depend on recommendations of evaluation reports of the panels of experts; however the prior condition has to be met.
3. All institutions which were in the process of validation and accreditation for ICT qualification are requested to bring to the offices of the National Qualification Authority the original and a copy of an agreement with the ICT qualification developers, each calendar year on defined date by NQA.
4. Rationale

Based on the request of the institution/provider dated: 15.01.2013, the Steering Council of NQA brings this decision based on the recommendations deriving from:

Evaluation report of the panel of experts on the validation of qualification,

Evaluation Report of the Panel of Experts for the Accreditation of the Institution which provides and/or assesses and issues approved qualifications, and these recommendations are supported by the following facts and documents:

- Application for validation of qualification/module;
- Application for accreditation as an institution which provides an/or assesses and issues qualifications;
- Self-evaluation report;
- Site-visit to applicant institution/provider;
- Other additional documents;

2.2 The unsatisfied party with the decision is entitled to an appeal to the second instance body. The appeal should be made through the first instance body.

3. The set condition for approval and accreditation should be met within the deadline set by NQA. In case the institution/provider does not meet these requirements, NQA keeps the right to withdraw its approval and accreditation.

4. Decision enters into force on the date of its signature.

5. Decision will be delivered to:

5.1 Applicant institutions;

5.2 NQA.
