The Steering Council of the National Qualification Authority, based on Article 4, paragraphs 1, 3, 6, 9 and Article 5 paragraphs 1, 2, 3 of the work Regulation of the Steering Council of NQA, as well as, in support of Articles 14, 15, 16, 17 of this Regulation, and based on the Law for national Qualifications (no. 03- L 0600), Article 10, Article 21.3, Article 22, and in support of the Administrative Instruction no. 0112011, approved by MEST on the Criteria and procedures for validation and approval of national qualifications and accreditation of institutions providing qualifications in Kosovo, based on Article 17 of the Regulation no. 02/2011 for the areas of the administrative responsibility of the Office of the Prime Minister and the Ministries (22.03.2011) as well as, in the decision of the Steering Council of NQA dated 30.03.2012, the Steering Council of the National Qualification Authority issues this:

DECISION

To raise the payment fee for external experts

1. The payment fee for one working day for an expert should be 100 euro from now on.

Rationale

Taking into consideration that the Administrative Instruction approved in February 2011 by MEST on the Criteria and procedures for the validation of approval of national qualifications and accreditation of institutions which provide qualifications in Kosovo the amount or fee to be paid to external experts has not been defined, the Steering Council of NQA has determined the amount/fee for a working day for external experts. The justification for this decision lies in the fact that the approved budget of NQA by the Government of Kosovo for the year 2012 is 284,38.50 euro, while in the category of goods and services there are 224,006 euro where these expenses are included. This increase of the fee from 80 euro per day to the amount of 100 euro per day is done with an aim of encouraging the application of professional experts, thus directly influencing quality and professional evaluations for VET providers.
